Mr Vizzone (a graduate from the Melbourne Conservatory of Music) visited our class last Friday to show the year one students a variety of musical instruments that he has collected from around the world. Assisting him with his presentation was Cadence, (who is also his daughter.)

The first was a U.F.O shaped drum. It is a hang (pronounced hung.) It comes from Berne in Switzerland.





The second was a small bell from Tibet.





The third and fourth are a rain maker and a thunder maker. The thunder maker has a cylinder with a membrane inside and a long spring hanging from it. The other is a cactus plant with the spikes pushed inside and then it is filled with husks. When slowly turned it makes the sound of gentle rain. These comes from Arizona in America.









Also from Arizona was an eight-sided drum covered in deer hide.

- Slice of Watermelon \$2










